Members are asked to complete and return this moorings requirements form to the RHYC office, indicating the year they wish to have a mooring.

DO NOT SEND ANY PAYMENT WITH THIS FORM, YOU WILL BE SENT AN INVOICE AND MOORING AGREEMENT FORM WHEN A MOORING IS ALLOCATED. THE MOORING MAY NOT BE USED UNTIL THE FEE AND SIGNED AGREEMENT FORM IS RECEIVED BY THE RHYC

IMPORTANT NOTES: Half-Tide moorings are only suitable for small lifting-keel or bilge-keel craft which can regularly take the ground.

There may be occasions, with especially low tides, when some deeper draft craft may ground on any River Orwell moorings.
